The Wellers had to fight back twice to salvage a point against Staveley Miners Welfare.

The visitors took the lead on 18 minutes as a move down the right wing wasn't closed down enough, and the resulting cross into the penalty area found James Gregory unmarked at the back post.

Gregory had time to pick his spot and curl the shot past Jono Davis.

It took just five minutes for the home side to be back on level terms as a corner resulted in a scramble in the box before the ball fell to Rikki Paylor, who had just

enough time to lay the ball into the path of Kane Reece who fired a shot into the opposite corner of the net.

The visitors re-took the lead five minutes into the second half from a corner of their own.

A ball floated in to the back post found centre-back Jack Allerton able to rise and head in his first goal of the season.

With time running out a surging run by Jordan Kershaw four minutes into added time found the striker with a narrow angle, but his shot somehow beat the keeper and took a deflection off the defender and in.

The trip to Beverley Town saw the return of defender Alf Thompson to the starting line-up after he had been missing through injury since late August.

Despite a good performance by Thompson he could do little to stop Joe McFadyen giving the hosts the lead on 29 minutes as the top scorer found himself free in the penalty area to bobble a shot over the on-rushing, low body of Davis.

Five minutes later a free-kick conceded by Craig Nelthorpe on the right wing corner of the penalty area allowed McFadyen to score his second.

The free-kick was placed around the wall and found the near post and pinged the ball in off the upright.

The Wellers struggled to get going in this game and matters weren't helped mid-way through the second half as Paylor's clearance inadvertently found the face of his own keeper.

Despite trying to continue, Davis failed to regain his composure and had to be replaced - leaving Paylor the man to go in goal for the final 20 minutes of the encounter.

With the lead secured though Beverley didn't try too hard to score another.

Wakefield AFC were formed in 2019 by a consortium which included former Manchester United and Sheffield Wednesday goalkeeper Chris Turner.

The club would begin life playing out of The Dorothy Hyman Stadium in nearby Cudworth and were accepted into the Sheffield & Hallamshire CSL Premier Division.

Wakefield would go on to have two failed attempts at completing their first season, with both the 2019/20 and 2020/21 campaigns cut-short by the COVID-19 pandemic.

When the club finally managed to complete a full season, it would turn out to be a memorable one.

In November 2021, VO2 Capital, a Connecticut-based family office took a majority interest at the football club.

During the takeover they replaced Adam Lockwood as head coach with former QPR youth team coach Gabriel Mozzini, allowing Lockwood to focus on a Director of Football role.

This restructuring brought about instant success, with the team going on an incredible 17 match unbeaten run in the league which ended with Wakefield being crowned league champions.

Strikers Jake Morrison and Billy Mole were inspirational during that run, with both scoring 20+ goals for the club.

Work had already begun on building the club as a whole, with Wakefield AFC women playing at Step 5 of the National Women's football system and a new development squad set to compete this season.

Last season saw Wakefield reach the playoffs in their first season of NCEL football, but fell to eventual promotion winners Rossington Main in the semi-finals by a single goal.

In 2023, the club achieved financial stability, launched Wakefield Juniors welcoming over 240 young players, and announced a move to Belle Vue in the heart of Wakefield.

This season has seen Wakefield floating around the top six of the league for the majority, with teams switching places regularly.

Like most of the current top seven they had a spell as leaders, and currently sit second.

Recently though manager Gabriel Mozzini was replaced - despite having beaten Retford FC 8-2 the previous evening.

Junior Roberti takes the helm for the remaining matches of the 23/24 season.
